The fragments were approximated and fixed by two screws, passed obliquely through both fragments across the line of fracture. The wound was closed completely, and a sterile gauze dressing wet with alcohol was applied over it, the limb being completely enclosed in a cast from the toes to the middle of the thigh. No infection followed. He was discharged from the hospital, November 22, walking on crutches. The cast was removed eight weeks after the accident and he could walk without crutches soon afterward. He had not worked since the accident because he could get no work to do; but he says he was able to work a few weeks after the cast was removed. April 16, 1922, he...
