Demosthenes, Aristotle, LXX) we find it with the article and the infinitive os rod ideit (Ac. 8: 40). In ikos reXous (2 Cor. 1:13), the phrase is almost adverbial. In D (Ac. 19: 26), tax Eccrou, Blass5 finds the notion of within....
